ARTICLE I
Definitions

§ 89-1. Words and phrases defined.

Whenever any words and phrases are used in this chapter, the meaning respectively ascribed to them in Subtitle 1 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes of New Jersey shall be deemed to apply to such words and phrases used herein.

ARTICLE II
**Prohibited Parking; Prohibited Stopping or Standing
and Time Limit Parking**

§ 89-2. Regulations not exclusive.

The provisions of this article imposing a time limit on parking shall not relieve any person of the duty to observe other and more restrictive provisions prohibiting or limiting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles as set forth in N.J.S.A. 39:4-138, any other New Jersey statute or as hereinafter provided.

§ 89-3. Parking prohibited at all times on certain public thoroughfares and public streets. [Amended 2-8-2001 by Ord. No. 4-01]

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the public thoroughfares, public streets or parts thereof described

in Schedule I (§ 89-23) attached to and made a part of this chapter.

§ 89-4. Parking prohibited during certain hours on certain public thoroughfares and public streets. [Amended 2-8-2001 by Ord. No. 4-01]

No person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified in Schedule II (§ 89-24) of any day (except Sundays and public holidays) upon any of the public thoroughfares, public streets or parts thereof described in said Schedule II attached to and made a part of this chapter.

§ 89-5. Stopping or standing prohibited during specified times on certain streets.

No person shall stop or stand a vehicle for the times specified in Schedule III (§ 89-25) of any day (except Sundays and public holidays) upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in said Schedule III attached to and made a part of this chapter.

§ 89-6. Parking time limited on certain streets.

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limit shown in Schedule IV (§ 89-26) at any time between the hours listed in said Schedule IV of any day (except Sundays and public holidays) upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule IV attached to and made a part of this chapter.

ARTICLE III

Limiting the Use of Streets to Certain Classes of Vehicles

§ 89-7. Trucks over four tons excluded from certain streets.

Trucks over four tons gross weight are hereby excluded from the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule V (§ 89-27)

except for the pickup and delivery of materials on such streets, said Schedule V being attached to and made a part of this chapter.

ARTICLE IIIA
Truck Routes

§ 89-8. Route for trucks over four tons.

Pursuant to N.J.R.S. 40:67-16.1, the streets or parts of streets as described in Schedule Va (§ 89-28) attached to and made a part of this chapter are hereby designated as a route for trucks over four tons which shall be excluded from all streets except from those streets which form a part of the system of truck routes.

ARTICLE IV
One-Way Streets

§ 89-9. One-way streets designated.

The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule VI (§ 89-29) attached to and made a part of this chapter are hereby designated as one-way streets in the direction indicated.

ARTICLE V
Through Streets, Stop Intersections and Yield Intersections

§ 89-10. Through streets designated.

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.R.S. 39:4-140, the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule VII (§ 89-30) attached to and made a part of this chapter are hereby designated as through streets. Stop signs shall be installed on the near right side of each street intersecting the through street except where yield signs are provided for in the designations.

§ 89-11. Stop intersections designated.

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.R.S. 39:4-140, the intersections described in Schedule VIII (§ 89-31) attached to and made a part of this chapter are hereby designated as stop intersections. Stop signs shall be installed as provided therein.

§ 89-12. Yield intersections designated.

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.R.S. 39:4-140, the intersections described in Schedule IX (§ 89-32) attached to and made a part of this chapter are hereby designated as yield intersections. Yield signs shall be installed as provided therein.

**ARTICLE VI
Loading Zones****§ 89-13. Loading zones designated.**

The locations described in Schedule X (§ 89-33) attached to and made a part of this chapter are hereby designated as loading zones.

**ARTICLE VII
Taxi Stands****§ 89-14. Taxi stands designated.**

The locations described in Section XI (§ 89-34) attached to and made a part of this chapter are hereby designated as taxi stands.

ARTICLE VIII
Bus Stops

§ 89-15. Bus stops designated.

The locations described in Schedule XII (§ 89-35) attached to and made a part of this chapter are hereby designated as bus stops.

ARTICLE IX
Turn Prohibitions

§ 89-16. Left turn prohibition.

No person shall make a left turn at any of the locations described in Schedule XIII (§ 89-36) attached to and made a part of this chapter.

§ 89-17. U-turn prohibition.

No person shall make a U-turn at any of the locations described in Schedule XIV (§ 89-37) attached to and made a part of this chapter.

§ 89-18. No turns.

No person shall make a turn at any of the locations described in Schedule XV (§ 89-38) attached to and made a part of this chapter.

ARTICLE X
Lane Use

§ 89-19. Lane use reservations.

The lane locations described in Schedule XVI (§ 89-39) attached to and made a part of this chapter are designated as lane use reservations, and traffic shall move only as indicated.

ARTICLE XA

Speed Limit Zones

[Added 6-13-1991 by Ord. No. 91-12]

§ 89-19.1. Speed limit zones designated.

The speed limit zones described in Schedule XVII (§ 89-40) attached to and made a part of this chapter are designated as speed limit zones, and traffic shall move only as indicated.

ARTICLE XB

Herma S. Simmons Elementary School[Added 5-23-1996 by Ord. No. 3-96¹]**§ 89-19.2. General parking.**

All vehicles must park in designated areas and between the lines provided.

§ 89-19.3. Bus parking.

The following described streets or parts of streets are hereby designated for bus parking only.

§ 89-19.4. Handicapped parking.

All stalls shall be 12 feet wide as shown on the attached site plan² and signed with R7-8 and R7-8P (reserved parking sign and penalty plate), in the designated parking areas for persons

§ 89-19.6. Through streets; stop and yield intersections.

- A. The speed limit for both directions of traffic in the parking lot(s) and roadway shall be 15 miles per hour.
- B. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limits authorized by the Department of Transportation.

§ 89-19.9. Towing of vehicles.

Any vehicle parked or standing as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic, block entrances or exit ways, loading zones, oil fills, any grassy area, pedestrian walkway or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owner's or operator's expense.

§ 89-19.10. Violations and penalties.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, every person convicted of a violation of this article or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$500 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or both.

§ 89-19.11. General parking; stopping and standing.

- A. All vehicles must park in designated areas and between the lines provided.
- B. No person shall stop or stand a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of streets described below.

§ 89-19.13. Speed limits.

Any vehicle parked or standing as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic, block entrances or exit ways, loading zones, oil fills, and grassy area pedestrian walkway, or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owner's or operator's expense.

§ 89-19.15. Loading zone(s).

The locations described are hereby designated as loading zones. No person shall park a vehicle in said location during the times indicated other than for the loading or unloading of good and materials.

§ 89-19.16. Signage.

All signs, posts, or other necessary materials be installed and paid for by the applicant. All signing shall conform to the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-198 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-183.27.

§ 89-19.17. Violations and penalties.

Unless other penalty is expressly provided for by New Jersey statute, every person convicted of a violation of this article or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$200 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days or both.

ARTICLE XE
**Parking Prohibited for Snow Plowing and Snow
Removal**
[Added 2-8-2001 by Ord. No. 3-01]

§ 89-19.19. Title.

The title of this article shall be "Ordinance to Prohibit Parking Temporarily for Snow Plowing, Snow Removal."

§ 89-19.20. Prohibited parking.

- A. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the public thoroughfares, public streets or public highways, an emergency shall exist, and no vehicle shall be parked on any of the public thoroughfares, public streets or public highways or parts thereof in the Borough of Clayton.
- B. The above parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased, until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will, not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.

§ 89-19.21. Removal of vehicles.

Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this article shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any police officer or Public Works Director may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.

§ 89-19.22. Violations and penalties.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violation or provision of this article or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$200 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or both.

ARTICLE XF**Little Ease Park****[Added 12-14-2006 by Ord. No. 33-2006]****§ 89-19.23. Speed limit.**

A ten-mile-per-hour speed limit is hereby established for the Little Ease Park driveway and parking lot area.

§ 89-19.24. Violations and penalties.

Anyone found to have violated this article shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100 but not to exceed \$500 per offense.

§ 89-19.25. Signage.

The Public Works Department shall install the appropriate signage for the driveway and parking lot area.

ARTICLE XG**Flashing School Crosswalk Zone****[Adopted 5-14-2009 by Ord. No. 3-2009]****§ 89-19.26. Location.**

The location of the Flashing School Crosswalk Zone on East Academy Street is as follows:

- A. Signal Number 1 is approximately 270 feet east of North Main Street and 275 feet west of North New Street.

B. Signal Number 2 is approximately 225 feet east of Pop Kramer Boulevard and 350 feet west of Turner Street.

§ 89-19.27. Speed limit.

Flashing School Crosswalk Zone when the single lights are flashing and children are present.

§ 89-19.28. Violations and penalties.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violation of this article shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$200 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or both.

ARTICLE XI

Penalties

§ 89-20. Violations and penalties.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, every person convicted of a violation of a provision of this chapter or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$50 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or both.

§ 89-21. Repeal.

All former traffic ordinances of the Borough of Clayton are hereby repealed.

§ 89-22. Short title.

This chapter may be known and cited as the "Traffic Ordinance."
