- 5. A copy of this resolution as well as the Contract shall be placed on file with the Clerk of the Borough of Clayton.
- 6. A notice in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law of New Jersey shall be published in <u>The Sentinel or South Jersey Times</u>.
- 7. The Mayor and Clerk of the Borough of Clayton are hereby authorized to execute a Contract outlining the above on behalf of the Borough of Clayton.

Dear Ms. Miller:

As requested, please accept this letter as this firm's formal proposal to the Borough of Clayton to update the language contained in the Borough's Municipal Code at Section 31A-1 to 31A-8 (Development Fee Ordinance) and Section 88-41 (the Unified Development Ordinance).

Estimating costs is an inexact process. So much depends on whether any issues arise and other factors. We would roughly that it would take approximately 20 hours of work and the total cost would be approximately \$4,050.00. This is a rough estimate and is based on the rates quoted in our agreement with the Borough. Our bills will be based on the time expended.

Included within that estimate is the time it takes to draft two ordinances, one updating the Development Fee Ordinances and one updating the Unified Development Ordinances, the time it takes to coordinate with the Fair Share Housing Center to ensure that the revisions are not inconsistent with or in violation of the Settlement Agreement dated November 7, 2016, the time it takes to coordinate with the Borough to facilitate introduction and adoption of the Ordinances, and attendance at the public hearing on the Ordinances.
