RESOLUTION 242-14

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE HAZARDOUS DISCHARGE SITE REMEDIATION FUND FOR CLEVENGER'S

Whereas, the Governing Body of the Borough of Clayton has determined that there has been, or suspects to have been, a discharge of hazardous substances or a hazardous waste on, or on a portion of, the property known as Clevenger Brothers Glassworks, hereafter referred to as the Clevenger property, involving Block 1203, Lots 13 & 14 in the Borough of Clayton;

Whereas, the Borough of Clayton is applying to the Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund for the assessment and investigation of Clevenger's in order to determine the extent of the known or suspected discharge of hazardous substance and/or waste;

Whereas, the Borough of Clayton has retained Rohan Tadas, CHMM, LSRP as Licensed Site Remediation Professional per the Site Remediation Reform Act to oversee and complete the assessment and investigation of the Clevenger site in order to determine the extent of the known or suspected discharge of hazardous substance and/or waste;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Mayor and the Borough Council of the Borough of Clayton Gloucester County, State of New Jersey that the Borough of Clayton is committed to the redevelopment of the Clevenger property for the purpose of residential or commercial development and finds that the realistic opportunity exists for the redevelopment of the Clevenger property within a three (3) year period of the date of completion of remediation of this site through a planned redevelopment project.

Be it further resolved that the Borough Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection for the Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund.
