WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-39 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated from the Outside Employment of Off-Duty Municipal Police Officers be accounted for in the Borough of Clayton General Trust Fund are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Clayton, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that Outside Employment of Off-Duty Municipal Police Officers monies be placed in the Borough of Clayton General Trust Fund and be considered a "Dedication by Rider to the 2020 Budget of the Borough of Clayton per LFN 2000-14 for the sole purpose stated above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Clayton, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Mayor and Council does hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to pay expenditures of the Outside Employment of Off- Duty Municipal Police Officers per LFN 2000-14.
- 2. The Clerk of the Borough of Clayton, County of Gloucester is hereby directed to forward two certified copies of this resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
