
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Clayton, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That Environmental Resolutions, Inc., of Mount Laurel, New Jersey is hereby hired to provide the sampling and analysis of potential pesticides associated with the site known as Former Wayne's Auto, 741 N. Delsea Drive, for a total amount not to exceed \$600.00.
2. The term of this contract shall be from May 14, 2020 to May 13, 2021.
3. Donna Nestore, CFO, for the Borough of Clayton certifies that \$600.00 is available through Ordinance 9-2012.
4. The Contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11-5(1)(a), and the Fair and Open Process because it is for services performed by persons authorized by law to practice a recognized profession.
5. A copy of this resolution as well as the Contract shall be placed on file with the Clerk of the Borough of Clayton.
6. A notice in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law of New Jersey shall be published in The Sentinel or South Jersey Times.
7. The Mayor and Clerk of the Borough of Clayton are hereby authorized to execute a Contract outlining the above on behalf of the Borough of Clayton.

Environmental Resolutions Inc. (ERI) is pleased to submit this proposal for the sampling and analysis of potential pesticides at the above referenced site, identified as Area of Concern (AOC) 8 in the 2016 Preliminary Assessment prepared by T&M Associates (T&M).

This AOC is the last AOC that requires investigation at this site.

### **Task 1: Delineation of Pesticide Contaminated Soil**

In accordance with the NJDEP Technical Guidance Document for the investigation of Historically Applied Pesticides, December 2018, ERI will collect two (2) soil samples on the subject property. Soil samples will be collected at depths of 0-6" below grade, or, if it appears the site has been raised topographically, will be collected 6-12" below grade.

Soil samples will be submitted for the following analysis: Arsenic, Lead and Target Compound List Pesticides. Samples will be submitted for standard (2 week) turn around time for results. The results of all the sampling will be included in a Site Investigation Report to be submitted under separate proposal.

No other activities will be included in this proposal. All terms and conditions of ERI's contractual agreement with the Borough of Clayton are in effect.
