**RESOLUTION DENYING RELEASE OF MAINTENANCE  
BOND FOR HOVBROS CLAYTON LLC, ABERDEEN – ESTATES  
– SECTIONS 2.4 FOR SITE IMPROVEMENTS (LANDSCAPING) DUE TO  
OUTSTANDING LANDSCAPING PUNCH LIST ITEMS**

*WHEREAS*, the applicant, Hovbros Clayton, LLC, Aberdeen Estates, has posted, pursuant to the requirements of the Clayton Development Regulation and Zoning Ordinance, Maintenance Guarantees, guaranteeing the improvements in conjunction with said project; and

*WHEREAS*, the said applicant has completed said improvements and has applied for a release of said maintenance guarantees; and

*WHEREAS*, the Borough Engineer has made an inspection and rendered a report, a copy of which is attached hereto, and made a part hereof, certifying that the improvements have not been completed; and

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED* by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Clayton, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, that the release of the aforementioned maintenance bond for Hovbros Clayton, LLC, Aberdeen Estates, be and hereby is denied as per the Engineers letter.

Dear Ms. Newcomb:

Pursuant to the request made by Applicant, we will complete our site visit on September 8, 2021 of the above referenced site to determine if the Landscaping maintenance bond amount can be released for the above referenced residential development.

The maintenance bond in the amount of **\$9,420.00** was approved under Resolution 159-20. Based on the findings of our past site observation, we are informing the Borough there is landscaping that has died or in the process of dying and must be replaced prior to the release of the maintenance bond. **As such, we would recommend that Council not release the maintenance bond until the landscaping work is replaced. We recommend the work be scheduled to occur in November 2021.**

The maintenance bond expiration date is **September 10, 2021**. Therefore, we request this matter be submitted for Council consideration at their September 9, 2021 meeting. A punchlist for the outstanding landscaping items will be submitted under separate cover.


