WHEREAS, Borough of Clayton is applying for funding to conduct Safe Routes to School Program along the school route for Clayton Middle School and Clayton High School within Borough of Clayton and

WHEREAS, the project will help to continue and improve the promotion and encouragement of pedestrian and bicycle access and safety for school children & residents, and

WHEREAS, maintenance of the facility within Municipal roadways, once constructed, will be assumed by Borough of Clayton with the exception of (1) local ordinances that places maintenance responsibility with each individual property owner;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of Borough of Clayton that it hereby supports the submission of a grant application for the *Safe Routes to School Program* within the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation and authorizes the Mayor, Manager and the Municipal Clerk to execute any and all documents necessary and related to the submission of said grant application or grant agreement.


