WHEREAS, funding for this contract shall be encumbered by the Borough of Clayton Finance Officers in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Clayton, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey as follows:

 That Gilbert J. Marshall of Marshall Geoscience, Inc., be and is hereby appointed as the LSRP for the Clevenger Brothers Glass Works, Inc. Project for the Borough of Clayton. 2. That the Mayor and/or Borough Administrator be and is hereby authorized to execute a Contract for said services on behalf of the Borough of Clayton.

Marshall Geoscience, Inc. (MGI) has prepared the following proposal and estimate of costs to provide Licensed Site Remediation Professional Services (Gil Marshall, LSRP 573785) to prepare and submit the NJDEP HDSRF grant application to perform a Site Investigation (SI) of the Clevenger Brothers Glass Works Inc. (Clevenger) site.

In 2015, the Borough of Clayton received a HDSRF grant in the amount of \$6,466.00 to perform a Preliminary Assessment of the Clevenger site. On behalf of the Borough of Clayton, T&M Associates completed the PA of the site and presented its findings and recommendations for additional site investigation activities in its Preliminary Assessment Report dated May 2019. The HDSRF SI grant application will include a detailed technical scope of work and estimated costs to investigate certain areas of concern identified in the 2019 Preliminary Assessment Report. Typically, the NJDEP and NJEDA approve grant applications for the continued investigation and remediation of sites for which previous HDSRF grants have been approved for preliminary investigations.

The cost to prepare the HDSRF SI Grant Application is \$3,800.00.
