- There is no longer a nighttime enforcement requirement.
- All officers must complete the attached daily activity report <u>All blocks must be completed on the form</u>. The report must be signed
 by the officer and his/her supervisor (<u>CANNOT BE SIGNED TWICE BY THE SAME PERSON MUST BE ACTUAL SIGNATURES PRINTED NAMES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED</u>).
- Your agency must complete and return the enforcement summary report with the total statistics for the mobilization from your agency. <u>All blocks must be completed.</u>
- The following financial paperwork must be submitted: Expenditure summary, salary detail form, payment voucher, and payroll certification. These forms must be signed by your CFO/Treasurer.

The enforcement summary report is due no later than <u>June 10, 2022</u>. This form should be returned directly to me. The remaining grant paperwork is due no later than <u>June 17, 2022</u>. Any delays in receiving the paperwork may lead to non-reimbursement of your grant money. If you are having problems completing your grant paperwork on time, it is important that you contact me as soon as possible, otherwise it may go unpaid.
