## **RESOLUTION 177-22**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the Borough of Clayton has determined that there has been, or suspects to have been, a discharge of hazardous substances or hazardous waste on, or on a portion of, the properties known as 305 and 309 E. Linden Street, Block 1203, Lots 13 and 14 in the Borough of Clayton; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Clayton is applying to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund for a site investigation of 305 and 309 E. Linden Street in order to evaluate areas of concern identified in a Preliminary Assessment completed for the subject properties; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Clayton has retained Gilbert J. Marshall, LSRP as its Licenses Site Remediation Professional in accordance with the Site Remediation Reform Act to oversee and complete the site investigation of 305 and 309 E. Linden Street in order to evaluate areas of concern identified in a Preliminary Assessment completed for the subject properties;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Clayton, Gloucester County, State of New Jersey that the Borough of Clayton is committed to the redevelopment of the 305 and 309 E. Linden Street properties for the purpose of passive recreation and finds that the realistic opportunity exists for redevelopment of the properties within a three (3) year period of the date of completion of the remediation of this site, either through the planned redevelopment project or for recreation and conservation purposes;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Borough Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund.
