RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF CLAYTON RESCINDING RESOLUTION R:179-2022 AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL CLERK TO REQUEST A NON-BINDING REFERENDUM QUESTION ON THE TOPIC OF APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE BOROUGH OF CLAYTON PARKS AND RECREATION ESCROW ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, the Borough of Clayton had previously adopted Resolution R:179-2022 on August 18, 2022 authorizing the Municipal Clerk to request a non-binding referendum question on the topic of appropriating funds from the Borough of Clayton Parks and Recreation Escrow Account to be placed on the November 8, 2022 General Election Ballot; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has decided to rescind Resolution R:179-22 at this time to afford additional time for the governing body to further explore, develop plans as well as an estimated budget for the proposed Recreation Center Expansion Project prior to placing any question on a General Election Ballot.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Clayton, in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that Resolution R:179-2022 adopted on August 18, 2022 authorizing the Municipal Clerk to request a non-binding referendum question on the topic of appropriating funds from the Borough of Clayton Parks and Recreation Escrow Account be and is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Gloucester County Clerk's Office to request removal of the ballot question from the General Election scheduled for November 8, 2022.
