Task 1: Preparation of Area of Concern Specific Remedial Investigation/Remedial Action Report

In accordance with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) Technical Guidance Document NJAC 7:26E, ERI will prepare an Area of Concern Remedial Investigation/Remedial Action Report (report) for the former Wayne's Auto Site. ERI will be able to complete the preparation of the report and submit same to the NJDEP, in approximately 30-45 days after authorization.

A copy of the Response Action Outcome will be sent to Gloucester County and to the NJDEP.

Task 3: Assist Borough of Clayton with Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund Documentation and Paperwork

ERI will assist the Borough in preparation of Close out documentation and paperwork to close out the Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund obligations.
