RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NO. 1, THE AMBIENT GROUP, LLC, FOR DEMOLITION OF STRUCTURE AT FORMER WAYNE'S AUTO SITE

WHEREAS, Donna Nestore, CFO, for the Borough of Clayton certifies that \$6,500.00 is available through Ordinance 9-2012.

WHEREAS, The Ambient Group, LLC has submitted Change Order No. 1 dated December 4, 2019 outlining the additional cost to the Borough for a total amount of \$6,500.00 for a new revised contract total of \$41,590.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Clayton, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey as follows on this 12th day of December, 2019 that the Borough Council does hereby approve and authorize Change Order No. 1 to the contract with The Ambient Group, LLC for Tank Removal and Remediation Services for an additional cost to the Borough of \$6,500.00, for a new revised total contract amount of \$41,590.00.
